

Electoral FAQs: The app offers answers related to electoral process.






Greetings, citizens!



How can the Voter Helpline App help illiterate citizens who cannot operate smartphones?





What if someone tries to misuse the C-vigil App to falsely accuse someone?

Rest assured, every complaint is treated with utmost seriousness and discretion.




I've heard about the Saksham App. How does it assist Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) in registering and voting during elections?

Firstly, the Saksham App provides comprehensive information on the registration process for PwDs. It guides them step by step, explaining the necessary documents, support services available, and any special provisions that may be relevant to their specific disability.



Additionally, the app offers features such as an accessible voter registration form,

which ensures that PwDs can complete their registration digitally and conveniently. It considers the diverse needs of individuals with disabilities, providing options for alternative formats, such as large fonts, screen readers, or voice assistance, to enhance accessibility.



During elections, the Saksham App continues to support PwDs. It provides information about accessible polling booths equipped with facilities like ramps, wheelchair accessibility, and Braille signage. The app also helps locate the nearest accessible polling station, ensuring a smooth and hassle-free voting experience.



The helpline number 1950 is your direct line to the Election Commission for all your election-related queries. When you call, you can expect prompt assistance in multiple languages. The well-trained team can provide information on registration, polling locations, candidate details, and address any complaints or grievances you may have. Dedicated helpline: The helpline number offers citizens a direct line to seek assistance, clarifications, or information related to the electoral process.




24/7 availability: The helpline operates round the clock, allowing citizens to reach out anytime they have queries or require support.

Steps to download ECI Applications

Open the app store on your smartphone. For Android users, it's the Google Play Store, and for iPhone users, it's the App Store.



If you're having trouble finding the app, don't worry! You can also download these applications directly from the Election Commission's official website. Just visit www.eci.gov.in and look for the "Mobile Apps" section. You'll find the download links there. Also, these applications do require an internet connection to function properly. Make sure you have an active data connection or are connected to a Wi-Fi network while using them.
